RE: Pardon Request #C279007 for Matthew Hutcheson, Inmate #14620-023

Dear President Trump,

My name is Annette Hutcheson and I am writing to you on behalf of my husband, Matthew D. Hutcheson who is currently incarcerated at FCI Englewood, and has been wrongfully incarcerated for 5 ½ years. In May of last year, I mailed to you and to the Pardon Attorney a pardon request for my husband. His case number is C279007.

I know that you are extremely busy with the shenanigans of the democrats, but if you could take a moment to review my husband's pardon request, our family would truly appreciate it. Matt is a good man, Mr. President, who is wrongfully incarcerated. This spring/summer we have a daughter getting married, a son getting married and a daughter who is graduating from high school. If you decide to grant Matt a full and unconditional pardon so that he is a free man before our children's weddings and graduation, we would weep with gratitude. Matt is an innocent man. He is a good man. He is an honest man, and he has been kept from our family for far too long.

A short overview of Matt's case is as follows:

- 1) While consulting with the U.S. Congress from 2007-2011, Matt was asked by influential lawmakers to create a private healthcare system that could be used as an alternative to Obamacare. The model he came up with utilized regulation 29 § CFR 2509.94-1. When the Obama administration learned of the plan that Matt had created, they felt it threatened Obama's legacy and created trumped-up charges to put Matt in prison and silence him.
- 2) At this same time, Matt was asked by some powerful friends in New York City to help investigate some unfounded charges against them from Obama's DOL. During Matt's investigation he learned of some trade-for-hire agreements within and between Obama's DOL employees and Wall Street. This, coupled with the DOL's anger towards him for not doing their bidding in certain court cases that he was acting as expert witness for them, turned Obama's DOL against Matt.
